## Resize AI in ON1 Photo RAW - Quick Guide

#### When to Use

Cropped too much? Image too small to print?

Resize AI upscales with AI-driven clarity for better print or web results.

#### **Before You Resize**

- 1. Edit First: Tone, Crop, Noise
- 2. Apply NoNoise AI or Tack Sharp AI
- 3. Crop as needed before resizing.

#### **Access Resize Al**

Right Bumper Panel > Click Al icon.

If missing: Window > Show Right Bumper.

#### **Resize Options**

Resize by:

- Dimensions
- Long/Short Edge
- Width & Height
- Megapixels (Recommended)

Avoid extreme upscaling to prevent artifacts.

## **Advanced Settings**

Method Options: 2023, Faithful, Fractals, Bicubic

Smoothness: Blend added pixels to reduce artifacts.

#### **Additional Tools**

Noise Reduction & Sharpening: Skip if done earlier.

Face Recovery: Use for portraits.

Film Grain: Only if skipping ON1 edits.

## **Exporting**

Click the checkmark to save your final image.

Recommended formats:

- TIFF (Best for print)
- JPEG (For web)

- DNG (Editable archive)

# **File Output**

New file saved in original folder (e.g., filename-resize).

Check Grid View (G) to find it.

# **Pro Tips**

Use Resize AI to recover resolution after cropping.

Helpful for prints, sharing, or scanned photo edits.
